

WINTER ITINERARIES



Winter

1-DAY

Day 1:

Revel in the magic of **Mount Robson** covered in snow. Bring your snowshoes so you can experience the trail to Kinney Lake in a completely different way. 4.5 km later, you'll be rewarded with views of the stunning **Kinney Lake**.

3-DAY

Day 2:

Travel a winter wonderland by **Dog Sled**. Feel the icy breath of winter glance past as you stay cozy and bundled up in the dog sled. Take turns driving the dog sled for a once-and-a lifetime experience.

Day 3:

When someone mentions winter in Valemount, one of the first words that comes to mind is "**snowmobiling**" - and for good reason. Valemount is home to several unique and expansive riding areas. Rent a snowmobile or take a guided tour for a day that will be on replay in your memory bank. Just make sure you're up to date on your AST (or book a refresher from the local provider).

5-DAY

Day 4:

Book a night in one of the many **backcountry cabins**. With options to **ski-tour**, **snowshoe**, or **heli-in**, there's something for everyone. Alternatively, you can spend the day at Canada's only sled-assist backcountry ski hill: **Crystal Ridge**.

Day 5:

If **cross country skiing** is more your style, you're in luck! With two separate ski areas, Valemount is the perfect place to stretch those legs. Between Valemount & Tete Jaune sits **Jackman Flats**, and just South of Valemount is the **Camp Creek network**.
