## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Trail runners, mark your calendars! The highly anticipated **Alpenglow 100 Trail Running Race** will take place on **July 4th – 6th weekend** in **Valemount, BC**. This exciting new event promises breathtaking views via high alpine terrain, climbing all the way up to 2400 meters / almost 7800ft, and will certainly be an unforgettable challenge for runners of all skill levels.

Valemount (Valley - Mountains) is the confluence of three mountain ranges; the Rockies, Cariboos and Monashees, and is located just around the corner from Mt. Robson (20 minutes away), which is itself just 1 hour west of world-famous Jasper, AB. Mt. Robson is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, and the second highest peak entirely within BC at over 3900m / 12,900 feet.

Whether you're a seasoned trail runner or a first-time participant, The Alpenglow 100 will offer a unique opportunity to connect with nature and push your limits. The race features **three different courses**, ensuring there's a perfect trail for everyone

- 35km, +/- 1700m / 5,550ft
- 60km, +/- 3300m / 10,800ft
- 100km, +/- 4800m / 15,750ft
