Day 1:

Revel in the magic of Mount Robson covered in snow. Bring your snowshoes or cross-country skis so you can experience the Berg Lake Trail in a completely different way. 4.5 km later, you'll be rewarded with views of the stunning Kinney Lake.

Day 2:

Travel in a winter wonderland by dog sled. Feel the icy winds of winter rush past as you stay cozy and bundled up in the sled. Take turns driving the dogs for a once-and-a lifetime experience.

Day 3:

When someone mentions winter in Valemount, one of the first words that comes to mind is "snowmobiling"- and for good reason. Valemount is home to several unique and expansive riding areas. Rent a snowmobile or take a guided tour for a day that will be on replay in your memory bank. Just make sure you're up to date on your AST (or book a refresher from the local provider).

Day 4:

Want to test your skating skills? Spend the afternoon on the ice at the Canoe Valley Recreation Centre where both hockey skates and figure skates are available to rent. If you have your own skates, enjoy beautiful mountain views as you glide along the frozen Cranberry Marsh.

Day 5:

If cross country skiing is more your style, you're in luck! With two separate ski areas, Valemount is the perfect place to stretch those legs. Between Valemount & Tete Jaune sits Jackman Flats, and just south of Valemount is the Camp Creek network.
